**Fauji Banta Singh Sep 02 2021 The stories in the collection are largely about the tribulations faced by Punjabi immigrants living in Canada from the early 1970s onwards. Coming from a rural agricultural background in the Punjab to an urban industrialized centre in one of the most advanced countries of the world, these migrants face numerous challenges as shown in these thirteen short fictional stories. Religion, traditional values and generational differences become points of contention in a changed economic, social and political environment as depicted in these stories. Track, for example, is the story of a family living a quiet and normal life in a small Punjabi village that is impacted by the attack on the Golden Temple in the mid 1980s, and ends in a suicide in a Toronto jail. Three stories, Father and Son, Fauji Banta Singh and The Song, deal with the lives of the elderly, victimized by their families who are conforming to an economic system that puts more emphasis on monetary gains than personal relations. The always-changing Canadian immigration laws often force people to resort to various underhand methods in order to gain entry and legal status in the country. As a result, they end up abusing each other and, more often than not, getting into**

illegal activities as well. This is evident in stories like 'yes in the Dark, he Burden'and 'New Job For Dale. he Broken Window'and 'armer Jerry'deal with racism and economic exploitation, two of the more prominent characteristics of Canadian society that many immigrants often face. 'y First Memory'and 'he Village School'are excerpts from a satirical novel (original in Punjabi) and show the life of a young person in a village. These stories of individuals and families also map out the development of a community that was completely marginalised until the end of the 1960s and became a vibrant part of the Canadian multicultural mosaic in the following three decades.
